6. County Councillor's Report from Cllr Stephen Davies	<p><u>Adult Social Care Loan team</u> Council has invested £6m in Technology Enabled Care for the Elderly. Adult Social Care have purchased 10 Electric Vehicles for their Equipment Loan Service.</p> <p><u>Flag Statement</u> has been published stating GCC will deal with flags on a case-by-case basis for safety reasons not politics.</p> <p><u>Gloucestershire Fire and Rescue</u> GFRS have won 2 awards, Road Safety in the Community Award and Public Sector Driver Award.</p> <p><u>Asian Fire Service Association</u> award for Equality and Diversity</p> <p><u>Gloucester Library</u> moved to old Debenhams building.</p> <p><u>Trading Standards</u> Trading Standards seize 200 counterfeit toys as Christmas approaches £4,000 of illegal tobacco seized hidden in a car. Gloucestershire County Council's Trading Standards service and Counter Fraud Team (CFT) are at the forefront of a major new initiative to tackle fraud, with the launch of a new website.</p> <p><u>Highways</u> Additional £300k for 20 mph and Safer Roads announced. A start but not enough. Gritter fleet have been named e.g. Gritting Queen, Gritfire and Feathers McGrit amongst 29 names</p> <p><u>Active Travel Level 3 award</u>. One of 6 Councils to receive this.</p> <p><u>LGR Vote</u> in October at Gloucestershire County Council was overwhelmingly in favour in "one" unitary. The next stage should be Public Consultation.</p>
